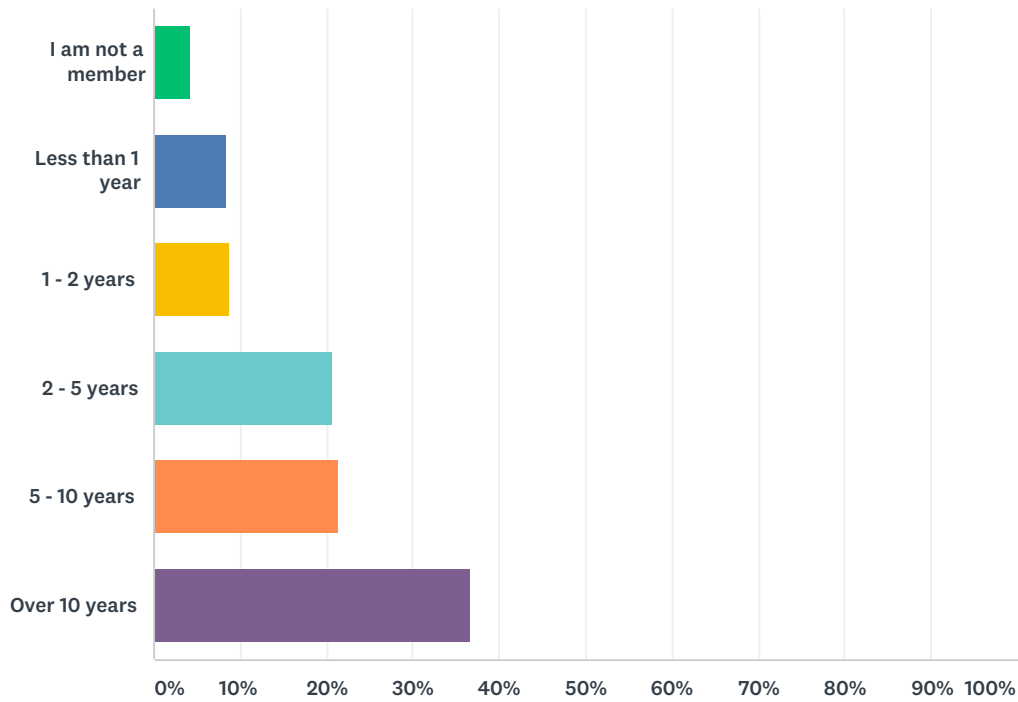


# Q1 How long have you been a member of Pony Club NSW?

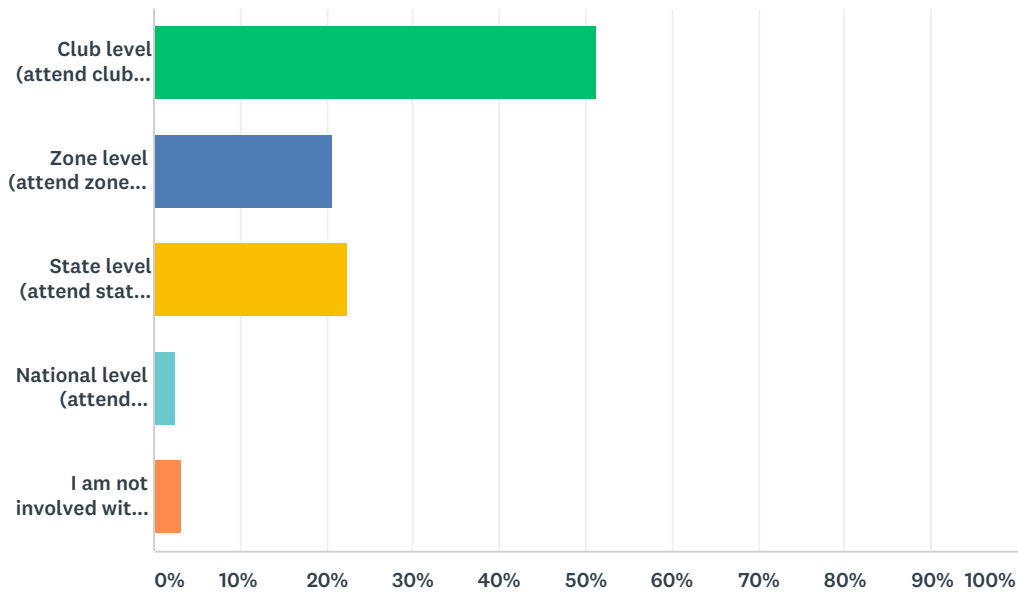

## Q2 What level of Pony Club are you involved in?

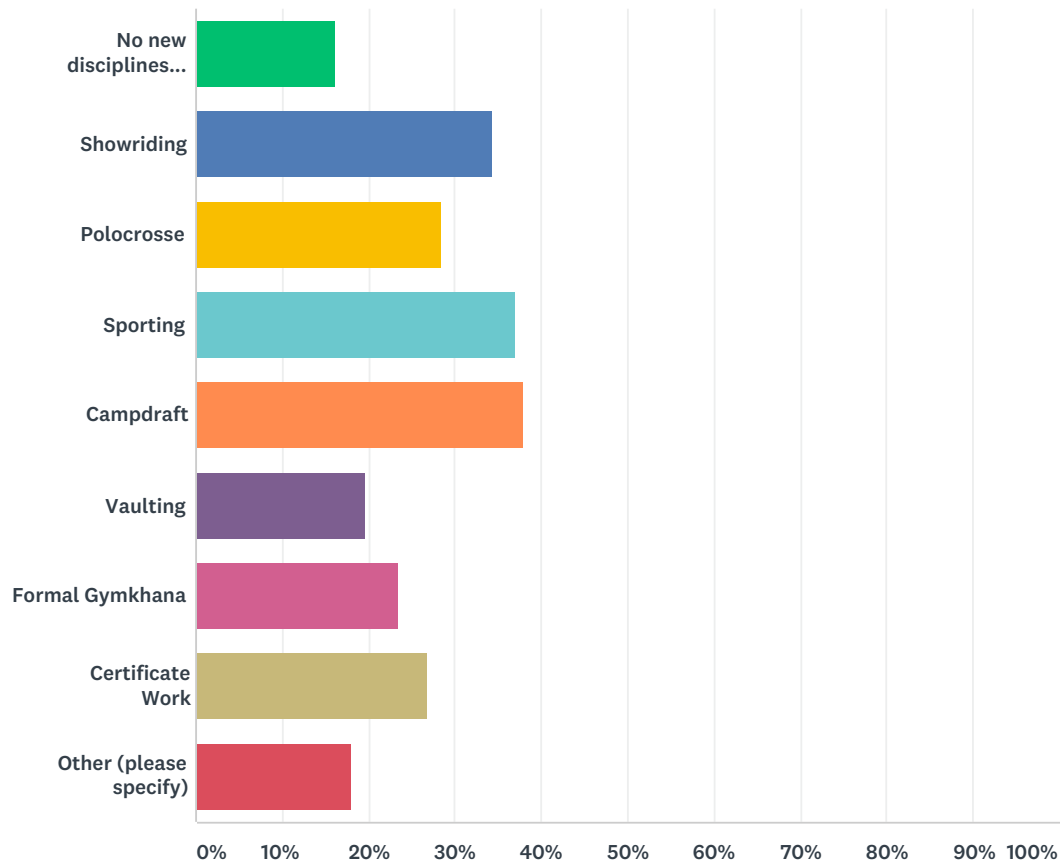

### Q3 Should new disciplines be offered at State Camp?

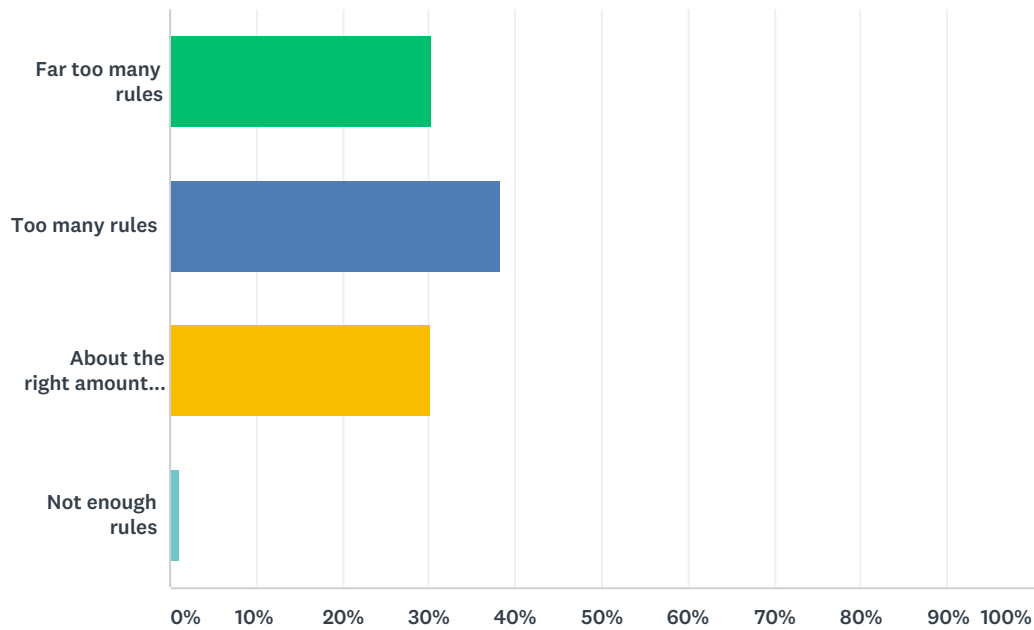

### Q4 One comment that has been made is that Pony Club NSW has too many rules. Do you think we have;

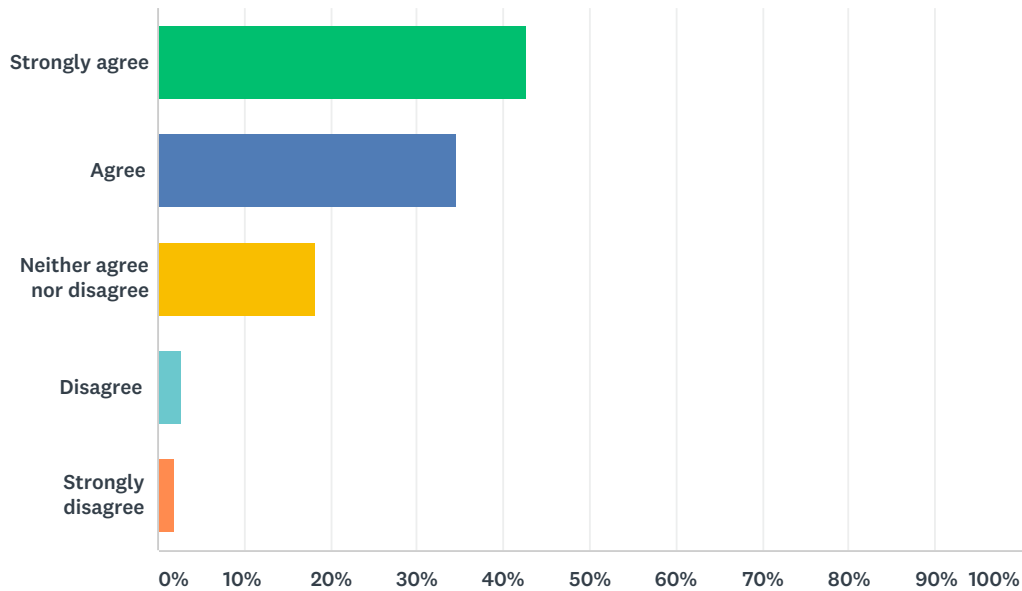

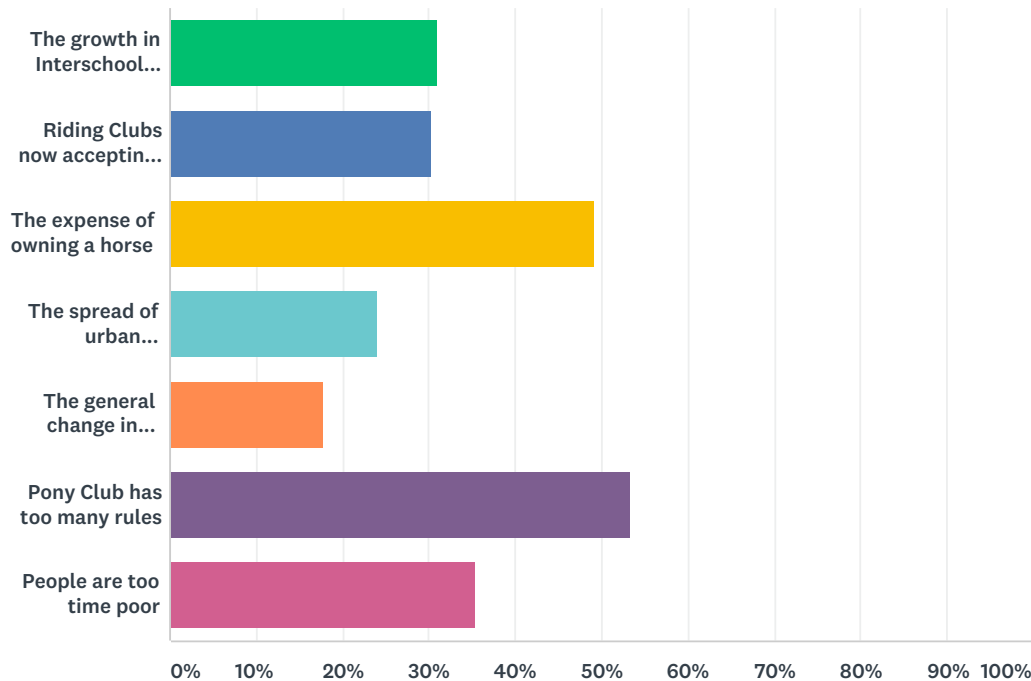

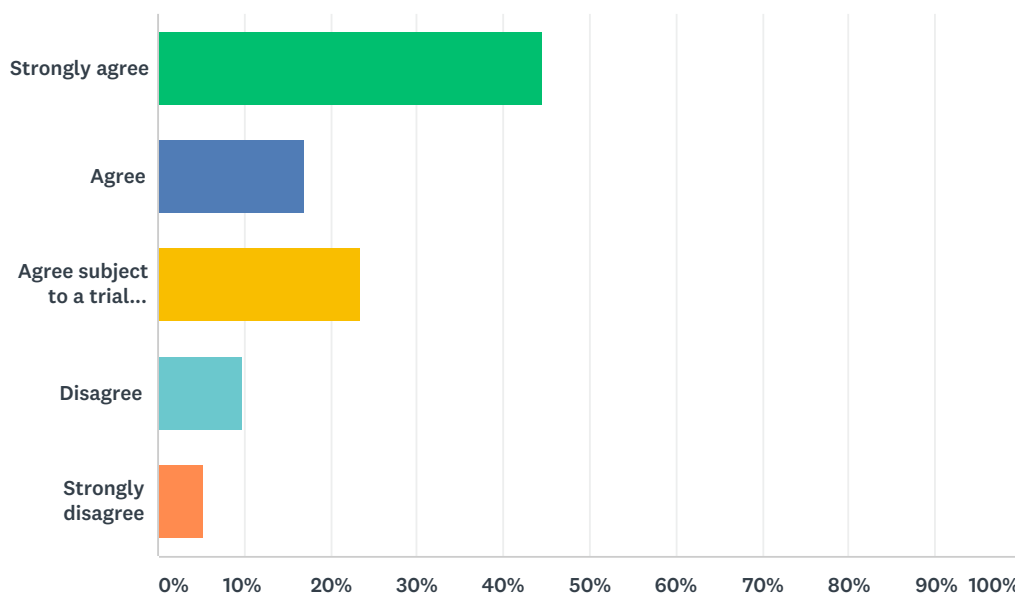

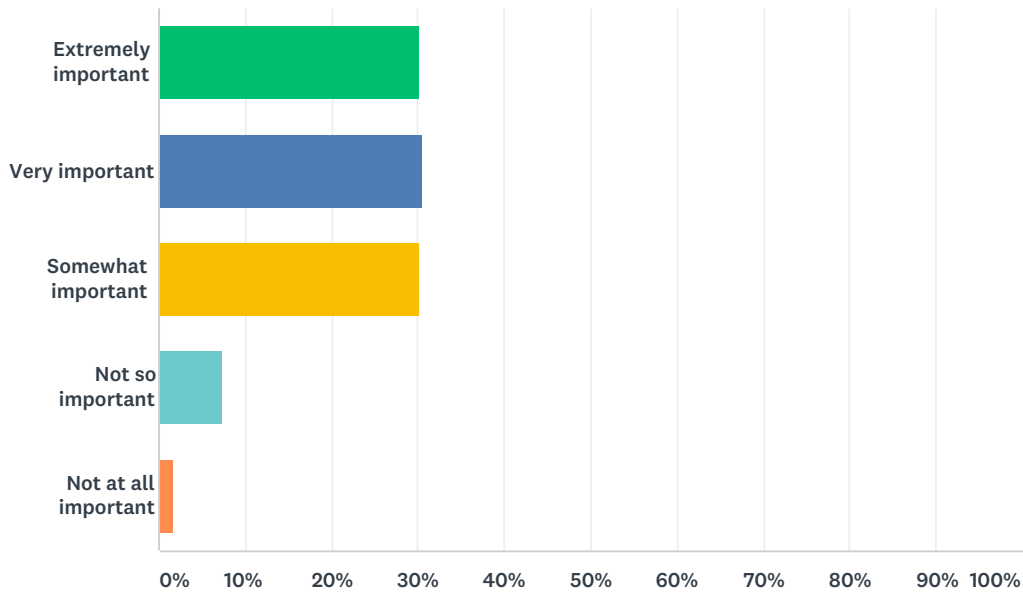
